### Tree and Shrub

<b>Ash-</b> native, but all susceptible to EAB	<i>Fraxinus</i> spp.
<b>Autumn Olive</b>	<i>Elaeagnus umbellata</i>
<b>Buckthorn: Common, Glossy</b>	<i>Rhamnus cathartica</i> , <i>R. frangula</i>
<b>Bush and vine honeysuckles</b>	<i>Lonicera maackii</i> , <i>L. morrowii</i> , <i>L. tatarica</i> , <i>L. japonica</i>
<b>Butterfly bush</b>	<i>Buddleja davidii</i>
<b>Callery pear</b> -includes cultivars i.e. 'Bradford Pear', 'Cleveland Select', 'Chanticleer'	<i>Pyrus calleryana</i>
<b>European alder</b>	<i>Alnus glutinosa</i>
<b>European highbush cranberry</b> – Avoid <i>V. trilobum</i> unless certain of species ID; they are often misidentified	<i>Viburnum opulus</i> var. <i>opulus</i>
<b>Glossy buckthorn</b>	<i>Frangula alnus</i>
<b>Golden raintree</b>	<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i>
<b>Japanese barberry</b>	<i>Berberis thunbergii</i>
<b>Japanese spiraea (meadowsweet)</b>	<i>Spiraea japonica</i>
<b>Mimosa/silk tree</b>	<i>Albizia julibrissin</i>
<b>Rose: Multiflora, dog</b>	<i>Rosa multiflora</i> , <i>R. canina</i>
<b>Norway Maple</b>	<i>Acer platanoides</i>
<b>Olive: Autumn, Russian</b>	<i>Eleagnus umbellata</i> , <i>E. angustifolia</i>
<b>Princess tree</b>	<i>Paulownia tomentosa</i>
<b>Privet: Chinese, glossy, Japanese</b>	<i>Ligustrum sinense</i> , <i>L. lucidum</i> , <i>L. japonicum</i>
<b>Rose of Sharon</b>	<i>Hibiscus syriacus</i>
<b>Sawtooth oak</b>	<i>Quercus acutissima</i>

<b>Wisteria: Chinese, Japanese</b>	<i>Wisteria sinensis</i> , <i>W. floribunda</i>
<b>Yellow flag iris</b>	<i>Iris pseudacorus</i>

This Do Not Plant list is not comprehensive, but includes some of our most common invasive, non-native plants as well as those not suitable for landscaping.
